Regulations on the Organization of the Educational Rocess and the Conditions for Training Peoplewith Disabilities, approved by the Order of SPbPUdated 11.12.2017 No. 2209

The Regulations determine the conditions for training people with disabilities in secondary vocational education programmes and higher education programmes: Schelor's degree programmes, Specialists programmes, Master's degree programmes, postgraduate training programmes for academic staffat FSAEI HEPeter the Great St Petersburg Polytechnic University

The Regulations definespecial conditions for training and areas of work for people with disabilities.

Special conditions are defineds conditions for training people with disabilities, including the use of special dyprogrammes and methods of training and education special textbooks handbooks and didactic materials, special technical teaching aids for shared and individual use, proding students with assistants for technical support, conducting group and individual correctional classes, providing access to the university building and other conditions, without which it is impossible or difficult to master sturby ogrammes for people with disabilities.

The University maintains a specialized record of people with disabilities in the information system at the stages of their admission, training raphdyment.

Upon admission to the University, special conditions are created for persons with disabilities, depending on the individual characteristics.

Students with disabilities are trainendstudy programmes at the University with the consideration of their specifips ychophysical development, individual capabilities and physical condition P

rehabilitation programme for a disabled person, regarding the recommended conditions and types of work.

The comprehensive support of the educational process and health preservation of students and postgraduate students with disabilities at the University are provided by institutes graduateschools, College. Support of the educational processor people with disabilities is carried out accordance with the recommendations of electeral institutions of medical and social expertise, psychological, medical and pedagogical commission.

The development and maintenance of the information technology base for inclusive education of people with distinctions are entrusted to the Office of Computing and Information Services, the Center for Open Education, the University Polytechnic College and institutes in which such categories of persons are trained.

Educational sites at the University are created with referentive to eeds of students, in particular, ensuring accessibility for people with disabilities.

When working out the issues of creating a barfriese architectural environment, the needs of various categories of people distribulities (with hearing impairments, visual impairments, with limited motor functions) are taken into account.

In order to comprehensively paparet the educational process of students and postgraduates with disabilities (if any), it is proposed to introduce the positions an educational psychologist (social worker), a specialist in special technical and software tools and other categories of workers, such as a texal opherisons who are hearing impaired, sign language interpreter, a visual impairment specialist.
